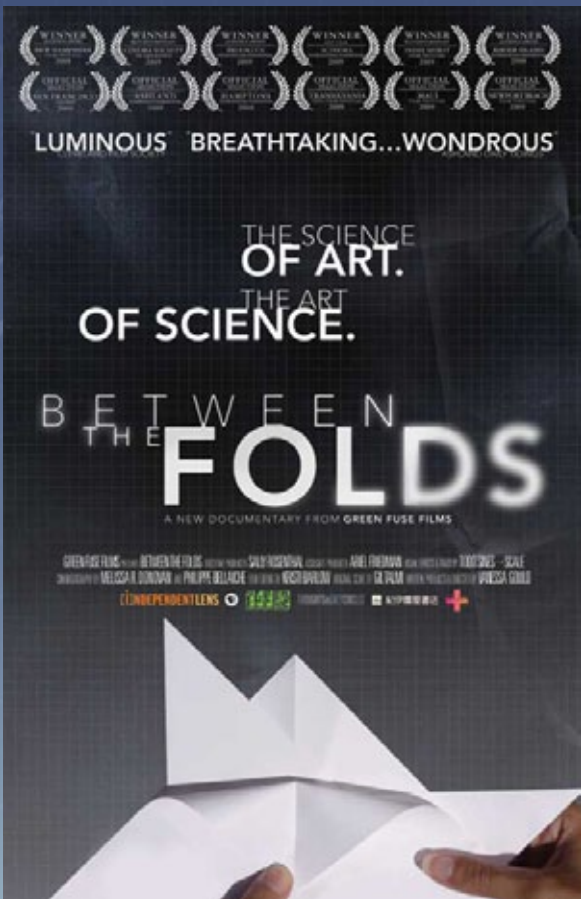

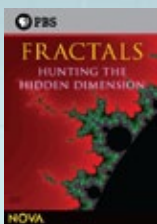

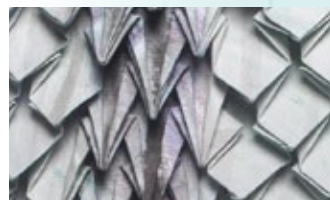


Hard Problems: The Road to the World's Toughest Math Contest
