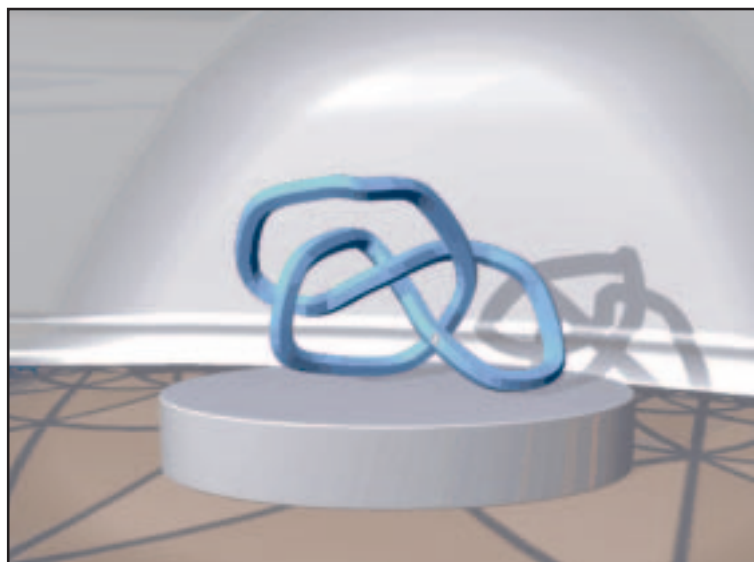
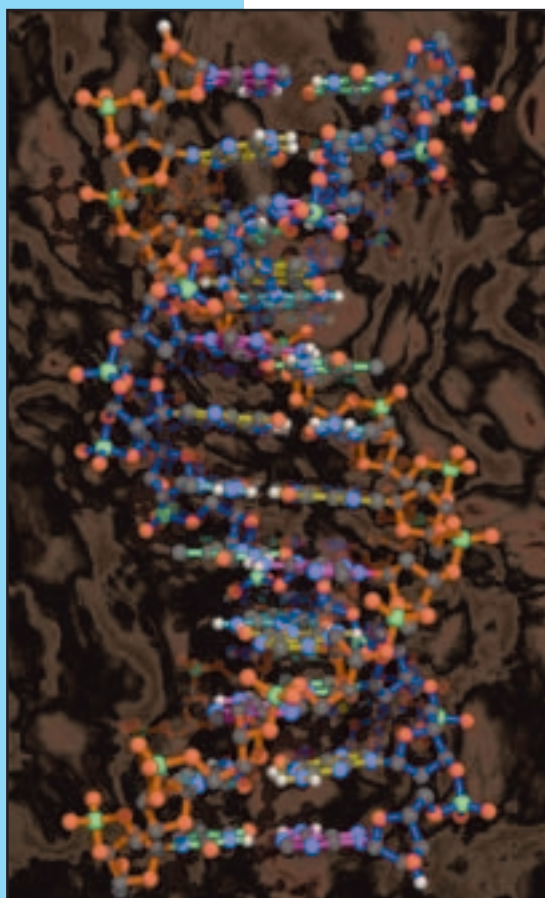




Deciphering DNA
