



Canning Spam

Email users ask the same question as surprised diners: Who ordered the spam? The answer is no one, but sending back email spam only brings more. People are fighting spam with many new tools, including filters that look for telltale signs that a message is spam. Spammers, however, defeat simple filters by disguising the words and intent of their messages. New, more sophisticated filters use mathematics to fight spam by training the filters to recognize spam over time, so that your server brings you what you want.
