The Grothendieck-Lefschetz theorem says the following: Let X be smooth projective variety over an algebraically closed field of characteristic zero and Y be a smooth hyperplane section. Further assume that $\dim(Y) \geq 3$. Then the natural restriction map of Picard groups is isomorphic. We prove an analogue of this in the context of normal projective varieties.
