Given a Quillen model category C, it is often convenient to establish a Quillen equivalence to a presheaf category. When C starts life as an enriched category, one would like a description as a category of enriched presheaves. We discuss conditions ensuring that one is in such a situation. As an example, we discuss the equivariant stable homotopy category as a homotopy category of presheaves of (nonequivariant) spectra on a suitable Burnside category. (Received February 11, 2008)
