The obstructions to the existence of canonical metrics in Kähler geometry are global, and expected to be encoded in destabilizing sheaves. A natural approach is to construct such sheaves as multiplier ideal sheaves, following ideas of Kohn, Siu, and Nadel. We describe recent work in this direction, in the context of Hermitian-Einstein metrics and of the Kähler-Ricci flow. (Received August 05, 2007)
