Noncommutative knot Floer homology (ncHFK) is a variant of combinatorial knot Floer homology with an Alexander 'filtration' taking values in a nonabelian group. The noncommutative grading lifts the integer-valued Alexander filtration in a certain sense. In this talk I will define the noncommutative Alexander filtration and the chain complex for ncHFK and discuss the difficulties that lie ahead. (Received January 16, 2015)
