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Mathematical Reviews

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This journal is the official organ of the Society. It reports official acts of the Society and the details of its meetings. It contains some of the officially invited addresses presented before the Society, reviews of advanced mathematical books, research problems and a department of research announcements.

One volume of six numbers is planned for 1968.

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This journal is devoted entirely to research in pure and applied mathematics, and is devoted principally to the publication of original papers of moderate length. Volume 1 appeared in 1950. The journal contains a department called Shorter Notes. The purpose of this department is to publish very short papers of an unusually elegant and polished character, for which there is normally no other outlet.

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
