We will introduce the notion of the categorical sequence σ_X of a space X. The k^{th} term of σ_X (for $k \geq 2$) is the least integer n for which $\text{cat}(X_n) \geq k$; or ∞ if no such n exists. We prove certain key properties of categorical sequences and show how to apply them. In particular, we will show that if $\pi_1(X)$ is free, then $\text{cat}(X) \leq \frac{2}{3}\text{dim}(X) + 1$.
